Deposit

To confirm your booking of Nora J we require a deposit of 50%. Until your deposit is paid we cannot guarantee availability on your chosen date.

Cancellations

Deposits may be returned, less a 10 percent administration fee, if we are able to secure another booking for that date and time.

All cancellations within 14 days for normal days or 30 days for "Special Event Days" will incur the full charge for the booking.

Pricing

All pricing is inclusive of GST and will remain current to 30 June 2015. A tax invoice will be issued on total charter cost once all details are confirmed.

Payment balance

You must pay the full balance of your booking at least 14 days prior to your function.

Extra time

If you choose to extend your cruise time on the day or prior, this will be charged in half hour increments. Any extension is also dependent on vessel and wharf availability.

Footwear and attire

Comfortable clothing recommended. Always bring a warm jacket as temperature can change rapidly when you are on the water. Non marking soled shoes must be worn at all times. Black soled or hard shoes must not be worn (including high heeled shoes and sandals) as these cause marking and damage to the yacht. Any marking or damage will incur a fee which will be deducted from the Security Bond. Bare feet is not recommended, but is acceptable.

Safety

All passengers must obey any safety directions given by the captain or crew. Common safety practices must be observed.

Swimming

Swimming is permitted when the vessel is at anchor. However any guest who jumps or swims off the vessel is responsible for their own safety.

Damage

The hirer is at all times responsible for the conduct of on board guests, any damage or theft to the vessel or its contents will be at the hirer's expense.
